



TERMS OF REFERENCE

SPORT TEAM SELECTION ADVISORY GROUPS

Mandate:

The Sport Team Selection Advisory Groups will function as a sub-committee of the High Performance Committee (HPC) and will advise the CTO and National Sport Coach on matters related to team selection in a specific cycling sport (BMX, MTB, Road, Para and Track).

The role of the Sport Team Advisory Groups will be to support and advise the National Sport Coach with regard to national squad and Team selection. It will be the responsibility of the National Sport Coach to work with each Advisory Group to select, based on the published selection criterion, the individuals for a particular project and/or campaign from the wider national Pool.

In the event of any conflict of interest being declared by a Sport Team Selection Advisory Group member the CTO or HPC may designate another member or simply decide that one Sport Team Selection Advisory member is sufficient.

Membership:

The HPC will appoint the individuals who will sit on the respective sport specific Team Selection Advisory Groups: for BMX, MTB, Road, Para and Track. Each Advisory Group will consist of two individuals who are acknowledged experts in that cycling sport with due consideration to gender and regional balance.

The Chief Technical Officer (CTO) will make an open call for Advisory Group members every two years to coincide with the publishing of National Team selection policies and procedures.

The HPC will select and appoint the members of each two person Advisory Group.

The appointed members will serve a two year term. Members may not serve more than three (3) consecutive two year terms.

Authority:

The 'Sport' Team Selection Advisory Group will provide advice to the National Sport Coach and/or Chief Technical Officer in the following areas:

- The implementation of National Team selections process for teams, projects and events.
- The nominations athletes for discretionary cards in the specific cycling sport for the Athlete Assistance Program.

Reporting:

The Sport Team Selection Advisory Groups will report to the High Performance Committee through the Chief Technical Officer.

The Advisory Groups will report to the CTO on matters of selection to National Team activities and the Athlete Assistance Program.
